 - Single, small carb, no V-12 or V-16 manifolds allowed
 - Karts deemed to fast by Bill McCornack will be moved to class 3 or 5
3. SINGLE REAR ENGINE ^{a,b} < 6.1 cu in – American Engines Only
4. SINGLE REAR ENGINE ^{a,b} > 6.1 cu in – American Engines Only
5. SINGLE ENGINE SIDEWINDER ^b <6.1 cu in – American Engines Only
6. EXPERT VINTAGE SIDEWINDER Foreign or American Engines <6.1 or >6.1 cu in
7. DUAL/TRIPLE REAR ENGINE ^{a,b} American Engines <6.1 or >6.1 cu in (each engine)
8. DUAL ENGINE OPEN ^c Any Foreign or American Engines <6.1 or >6.1 cu in
