

Counter-proposals must be submitted to the Rules Committee Chairman in writing with 5 (Members Only) verifiable signatures for Board approval prior to the end of the September 29th Race Day. Any and all counter-proposals must be submitted on a BKC Counter-proposal form ONLY which can be downloaded from the Badger Website. Board-approved counter-proposals will be presented in a mailing to the membership. Submit any questions or counter-proposals to Rules Committee Chairman George Sieracki at rules@badgerkartclub.com.

Beginning January 1, Briggs 206 racers will be required to use engine seals featuring a black integrated thread wire or a red/black integrated with and orange seal housing. This is per the Briggs 206 United States Rule Set, Rule 6 on page 6. Following the Briggs Rule Set in its entirety is required for Badger Kart Club to participate in the Briggs Weekly Racing Series.

A word regarding age requirements: A driver who reaches the age for a class during the season will be able to race that class the entire year, with the exception of Kid Kart drivers who must be 5 years old. Example: Joe Driver is 11 but turns 12 on July 3rd. Because he turns 12 before December 20th, 2019, Joe will be allowed to race in Junior classes (12-15) or in Sportsman classes with a maximum age of 12. Joe cannot compete in both classes or move from Junior to Sportsman without approval of the Board of Directors.
